Summary

Julián Cárdenas has gathered more than 11 years of experience in teaching and another 7 years in postdoctoral positions, covering a broad spectrum of research methods and techniques, ranging from multivariate data statistics to network analysis, content analysis and fuzzy set qualitative comparative analysis (fsQCA). Julián Cárdenas earned his Ph.D. in Sociology from the University of Barcelona in 2007, which obtained the extraordinary doctorate award. He became Lecturer at the University of Barcelona, and Postdoctoral Researcher at the IESE Business School in Spain (2006-2009). Thanks to his excellent performance, he got a position as Associate Professor at the Universidad de Antioquia, the second-best public university in Colombia (2009-2014) according to the QS rankings. In 2013, he applied and obtained a big research grant in an international competitive call and became the principal investigator (PI) of a research project based at the Freie Universität Berlin, Germany (2013-2017). In 2016, he got a position as Lecturer at the Alice Salomon University in Berlin (Germany) to teach networking and statistics, and he was recruited as online course instructor to teach statistics and research methods using R software packages at the Universitat Oberta de Catalunya. Along his experienced international teaching career, he taught several sociological subjects and became the supervisor of 5 Ph.D., 40 Master and 9 Bachelor theses from German, Mexican, Colombian and Spanish universities. Moreover, he was the academic coordinator of the Master's degree in Sociology at the Universidad de Antioquia in Colombia.

His main research interest focuses on powerful people networking. He attempts to figure out how elites are organized, why elites are differently organized, and what are the impacts of elite networks on several issues such as inequality, state capture, media freedom, innovation and sustainable development. He also undertook research on social entrepreneurship and bibliometric networks. His major research contributions are published in Q1 sociological and social sciences journals such as *International Journal of Comparative Sociology*, *Global Networks*, *Journal of Business Ethics*, *International Sociology*, and *América Latina Hoy*. He is the single author of most his publications, including 7 articles in Scopus journals and a book published in the CIS (Centro de Investigaciones Sociológicas). These achievements evidence Julián's intellectual independence and autonomy to develop high-quality research. His publications have received 484 citations according to Scholar Google, 162 according to Scopus, and 141 to ISI Web of Science.

Julián Cárdenas has shown outstanding leadership and cooperative qualities by successfully running 3 funded research projects as a principal investigator, and by participating in 9 more R+D research projects, including a European Commission-funded research project. As principal investigator, he managed the research and the funding for the projects and made appropriate resource allocation decisions. Building on that, he created his own research group-network focused on the study of Latin American elites (Red Élités América Latina - REAL), and a spinoff to provide consulting and training services to companies and organizations. He coordinated several knowledge transfer activities, including social impact reports, consultancy, and e-learning courses. Julián Cárdenas has 2 blogs, one of them with more than 1,000 visitors per day (the 3rd most visited blog on Sociology in Spanish), to disseminate his research and upload tutorials on how to do research using statistics, big data, graph theory, and social network analysis. Moreover, he organizes regular open talks and online events such as courses and webinars to make Sociology, data analysis, and network analysis more public and available to the general population. He presented his research findings in 45 scientific conferences (on average 3 per year since 2002). He also organized workshops and conferences, one of them with more than 1,000 participants attending (*Congreso Sociología Colombia-2014*). This work shows his ability to fundraising, management of public funds, coordination of large workgroups, teambuilding and his engagement with institutional events about sociological research.

Julián Cárdenas is editor of the Spanish Journal of Sociology, a Q3 Scopus journal, and a member of the editorial board of two other social science journals. The Spanish University Agency of Evaluation (ANECA) and the Catalan University Agency of Quality (AQU) certified his teaching and research career and accredited him as Associate Professor (Profesor Contratado Doctor – Profesor Agregat), Assistant Professor (Profesor Ayudante Doctor) and Associate Professor at private universities (Profesor de Universidad Privada).
